Mr. James Strong has assigned numbers to all Hebrew and Greek words in the Bible in alphabetical order according to both languages (separately). This helps us to identify where the original words are used throughout the Bible and develop a definition of a word or phrase in the way that the Lord has written.

## 1. DEFINITION OF GOD FROM THE BIBLE

The following are some Hebrew Old Testament and Greek New Testament words that are names, titles or descriptions that pertain to God in the Bible. These words and Biblical references give an overview and introduction to God's person. These words must be compared with the rest of the Bible (rightly divide the Word of truth -2 Timothy 2:15 – the Bible) in order to understand about this Almighty God who has created the heavens and earth as well as all mankind and creation.

- A. 'Elohim' OT#430 – may refer to God Himself (Genesis 1:1, 5:1, 20:17, Job 1:1, Psalm 4:1), any human that is appointed to some type of rulership on earth (i.e. Exodus 7:1, 22:8,9,28) or any false gods/idols (i.e. Exodus 34:16,17, Deuteronomy 6:14)
- B. 'El' OT#410 – Genesis 14:18, Joshua 22:22, Psalm 22: 1
- C. 'Yahveh' OT#3068 – Genesis 2:4,5,7,8,9, Exodus 3:2,4,7, Deuteronomy 4:35, 1 Kings 8:60, Ezra 1:7, Job 1:6,7,8, Psalm 1:2,6, 23:1, 33:12, 100:3, 110:1,2,4, 118:27, 144:15, Proverbs 1:7, Haggai 1:14, Zechariah 1:7
- D. 'Adon' OT#113 – May be a reference to God or a man > reference to God – Genesis 18:12, Exodus 23:17, Joshua 3:11, Psalm 8:1 (our Lord), 45:11 > reference to man – Genesis 24:9 (his master), 32:18 (lord – Esau), Isaiah 36:8 (my master)
- E. 'Adonai' OT#136 – always a reference to God – Genesis 15:2, Job 28:28, Psalm 68:11,17,19,20,22,26,32, 86:15, Isaiah 3:15, Daniel 9:4
- F. 'Shaddai' OT#7706 'Almighty' – Genesis 17:1, 49:25, Job 5:17, 33:4, Psalm 68:14, 91:1, Ezekiel 1:24, 10:5, Joel 1:15
- G. 'Theos' NT#2316, God Himself – Matthew 1:23, John 3:2, Romans 1:1,24, 1 Corinthians 8:6, Christ – John 1:1, 20:28, Romans 9:5, 1 Timothy 3:16, One in some type of authority – 'god(s)' >John 10:34 (NT#2316), Acts 28:6, 1 Corinthians 8:5, an idol – Acts 7:40, 12:22, 14:11, 19:26
- H. Pantokrator NT#3841 'Almighty' – 2 Corinthians 6:18, Revelation 1:8, 4:8, 11:17, 15:3, 16:7,14, 19:15, 21:22
- I. The Godhead – 'theios' NT#2304 – Acts 17:29, 2 Peter 1:3,4 (divine), 'theiotes' NT#2305, Romans 1:20, Colossians 2:9 (NT#2320)
- J. Lord – kurios – NT#2962 – God Himself – Matthew 1:22 Mark 12:29, Luke 4:8, Acts 2:39, Revelation 4:8, Christ – Matthew 7:22, Mark 7:28, Luke 5:8, Acts 9:5,6, Revelation 22:21, Earthly Authorities –John 13:16, Acts 16:19 (masters), 1 Corinthians 8:5, Colossians 4:1 (masters)

## 2. PERSON OF GOD

The Bible presents God in three persons that have personality but yet refers to God as being one God (Malachi 2:10, Mark 12:32, 1 Corinthians 8:6, Ephesians 4:6, James 2:19), not three Gods.

### A. Father

- 1) References to being God – Psalm 68:5, 103:13, Isaiah 9:6, 63:16, 64:8, Matthew 5:16,45,48, 6:1,4,6,8,9,14,15,18,26,32, 7:11,21, 10:20, 12:50, John 3:35, 4:23, Romans 1:7, 15:6, 1 Corinthians 1:3, Ephesians 4:6, 5:20, Colossians 1:12, 3:17, 1 Thessalonians 3:11, Hebrews 12:9, James 1:17, 1 Peter 1:2, 1 John 4:14, 2 John 1:9

  - a) God and the Father – 2 Corinthians 1:3 (should be translated as ‘and’), Ephesians 5:20, Colossians 1:3, 3:17, James 1:27, 3:9 (should be translated as ‘and’, not ‘even’)
  - b) God and our Father – Galatians 1:4, Philippians 4:20, 1 Thessalonians 1:3
  - c) Other references – Colossians 2:2 (mystery of God, and of the Father and of Christ), 1 Thessalonians 3:11 (Now God Himself and our Father, and our Lord Jesus Christ...), 2 Thessalonians 2:16 (Now our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and God and our Father...)

### B. Son References to being God –

*Psalm 2:7* – “I will declare (OT#5608) the decree (OT#2706): the LORD (OT#3068) hath said (OT#559) unto me, Thou *art* my Son (OT#1121); this day (OT#3117) have I begotten (OT#3205) thee. (see Acts 13:33, Hebrews 5:5)

*Psalm 2:12* – Kiss (OT#5401) the Son (OT#1248), lest he be angry (OT#599), and ye perish (OT#6) *from* the way (OT#1870), when his wrath (OT#639) is kindled (OT#1197) but a little (OT#4592). Blessed (OT#835) *are* all they that put their trust (OT#2620) in him.

*Isaiah 9:6* – For unto us a child (OT#3206) is born (OT#3205), unto us a son (OT#1121) is given (OT#5414): and the government (OT#4951) shall be upon his shoulder (OT#7926): and his name (OT#8034) shall be called (OT#7121) Wonderful (OT#6382), Counsellor (OT#3289), The mighty (OT#1368) God (OT#410),

The everlasting (OT#5703) Father (OT#1), The Prince (OT#8269) of Peace (OT#7965).

C. Holy Spirit – References to being God –

- 13) John 15:26 "... the Comforter ... the Spirit of truth, ..." sent by Christ from the Father
- 14) Acts 2:33 – Christ sits at the right hand of the Father and has received of the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit
- 15) Acts 7:56 – Stephen sees in a vision the Son of Man (Christ) standing on the right hand of God
- 16) Acts 10:38 – God anointed Jesus with the Holy Spirit
- 17) Romans 1:1-4 – God and His Son Jesus Christ
- 18) Romans 5:5 – Reference to the love of God by the Holy Spirit
- 19) Romans 15:13 – Reference to God working through the power of the Holy Spirit
- 20) 1 Corinthians 2:10 "... God hath revealed *them* unto us by his Spirit: ..."
- 21) 1 Corinthians 6:11 "... washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God."
- 22) 2 Corinthians 13:14 "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost ..."
- 23) Galatians 4:6 "... God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son ..."
- 24) Ephesians 2:18 "For through him (Christ) we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father."
- 25) 2 Thessalonians 2:13 "... God hath ... chosen you ...through sanctification of the Spirit ..."

#### **4. GOD REVEALED IN THE FORM OF A PHYSICAL OBJECT AND MAN IN THE OLD TESTAMENT**

##### **A. Physical Object**

- 1) Burning Bush – Exodus 3:2-4, Mark 12:26
- 2) Pillar of Cloud/Fire – Exodus 13:21, 19:9,18, 34:5, Numbers 12:5
- 3) Whirlwind – Job 38:1, 40:6

##### **B. One or More Men Mentioned as being God on Earth**

- 1) Genesis 18:1-3,21,22, 19:13,24 – The three/two men [enosh OT#582] (angels OT#4397) are called lord (OT#136) and lords (OT#113) and destroy the city of Sodom and Gomorrah as Yahveh. Both Abraham and Lot in both events bow ('shahah' OT#7812) or worship the men who come to them.
- 2) Genesis 32:24-30 – Jacob wrestled a man (iysh OT#376). In verse 30, Jacob calls the man that he wrestled with God (Elohim OT#430).
- 3) Joshua 5:13-15 – Joshua meets a man (OT #376) who says that he is the captain of the LORD's army. Joshua bows down (OT# 5307, 6440, 776) and worships him (OT #7812) and the man states that the place where he is standing is holy (OT #6944).

- 4) Judges 13:6,10 – The angel is called a man (iysh OT#376). In verse 22, Manoah says that this angel was God (Elohim – OT#430).
- 5) Isaiah 9:6 – a son is to be called “The mighty God” (Gobbhor – OT#1368, El – OT#410)

## 5. DEITY OF CHRIST – JESUS IS YAHVEH GOD

- A. The LORD (Yahveh or Jehovah) was pierced in Zechariah 12:10 which foretold concerning the crucifixion of Christ in John 19:37.

“And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.”  
*(Zechariah 12:10)*

“And again another scripture saith, They shall look on him whom they have pierced.” *(John 19:37)*

The one who was pierced in John chapter 19 is clearly Jesus Christ. The one who was pierced in Zechariah 12:10 which the me refers to is the LORD who is speaking to Zechariah throughout the whole chapter (see 12:1,4).

These two passages are either contradictory to each other or they are teaching that Yahveh and Jesus are the same (or as Jesus said “... I am in the Father and the Father in me ...” John 14:10).

- B. The name upon which anyone can be saved from the penalty of their sins is that of the LORD and Jesus Christ. In Acts 4:12 and in other places in the New Testament, it is clear that salvation can only be obtained by Christ (His name).

“Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.” *(Acts 4:12)*

“But as many as received him, to them gave he power (authority) to become the sons of God, to them that believe on his name.”  
*(John 1:12)*

“To him give all the prophets witness, that through his name whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins.” *(Acts 10:43)*

In these three verses, it is clear from their contexts that the name to believe upon for forgiveness of sins is Jesus Christ. See also John 3:18, 20:31 and 1 Corinthians 6:11.

However, when we read elsewhere of a name which brings salvation, we find in Romans 10:13 which is a quote from Joel 2:32, that it is the name of the LORD which brings salvation.

“And it shall come to pass, whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call.” (Joel 2:32)

“For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.” (Romans 10:13)

Only when we recognize that the names LORD and Jesus Christ bring the same forgiveness of sins do we see that they must be in harmony. The name ‘LORD’ in capital letters in the King James Version throughout the Old Testament signifies that this is Yahveh, a name of God Himself. The New Testament does not use the name Yahveh but assigns the name or term Lord (‘kurios’ in the original Greek text) in quotations from the Old Testament in places such as Romans 10:13. Since Acts 4:12 declares that salvation can only be from the name of Christ (“*there is none other name...*”) and yet Romans 10:13 which is a quote from Joel 2:32 declares that the name of Yahveh brings salvation, then the name of Christ and Yahveh must be one.

- C. Every knee will bow to the LORD and to the Lord Jesus Christ, but not to God the Father.

“Tell ye, and bring them near; yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? who hath told it from that time? have not I the LORD? and there is no God else beside me; a just God and a Savior; there is none beside me. Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else. I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.” (Isaiah 45:21-23)

“Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.” (Philippians 2: 9-11)

Jesus Christ will be exalted and acknowledged in the same way that the LORD will be. All are to look to the LORD to be saved as to Jesus Christ. The 'every knee' in view will bow to both Yahveh and Christ.

- D. After the end of the world, in Heaven, there will be no sun for light as we have here in this universe, but there will be light coming from the LORD and Jesus Christ.

“The sun shall be no more thy light by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto thee: but the LORD shall be unto thee an everlasting light and thy God thy glory. The sun shall no more go down; neither shall the moon withdraw itself: for the LORD shall be thine everlasting light, and the days of thy mourning shall be ended.” (Isaiah 60:19,20)

“And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof. And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it ...” (Revelation 21:23,24a)

- E. Jesus is to receive glory, honor and power

Who is to receive glory and honour and power? Is it not to God and God alone? Consider the following verses which attribute glory and honour and power to both God and Jesus.

“Glory and honour are in his presence; strength and gladness are in his place.” (1 Chronicles 16:27)

“Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all.” (1 Chronicles 29:11)

“Honour and majesty are before him: strength and beauty are in his sanctuary” (Psalm 96:6)

“I am the LORD: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.” (Isaiah 42:8)

“For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.” (2 Peter 1:17)

“Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.” (Revelation 5:12)

“See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand.” (Deuteronomy 32:39)

F. Separate statements of the one work (devil cast out of) called “great things” that were done to a man by God and by Christ – Luke 8:39

“Return (NT#5290) to (NT#1519) thine own (NT#4675) house (NT#3624), and (NT#2532) shew (NT#1334) how great things (NT#3745) God (NT#2316) hath done (NT#4160) unto thee (NT#4671). And (NT#2532) he went his way (NT#565), and published (NT#2784) throughout (NT#2596) the whole (NT#3650) city (NT#4172) how great things (NT#3745) Jesus (NT#2424) had done (NT#4160) unto him (NT#846).”

G. Jesus Will Be the God of the Believers in Heaven

“He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.” (Revelation 21:7)

The context in verse 6 is referring to Christ as the alpha and the omega. (See Revelation 22:13-16)

H. Further Comparisons Between God and Christ

Note: A set of brackets [ ] notes one or more verses that unite both God/Yahveh and Christ in God’s mysterious way.

## 6. JESUS AS THE SON OF GOD

- A. The Son of God receives worship – Matthew 14:33
- B. The Son of God is feared by the demons/ unclean spirits – Mark 3:11, Luke 8:28 (called the Most High (NT#5310))
- C. Called the Son of God and the King of Israel – John 1:49 (a title used by Yahveh God – see Isaiah 44:6, Zephaniah 3:15, John 12:13)
- D. The Son of God as a holy title not to be used by any human being – John 19:7
- E. The Son of God was without sin – John 8:46, Hebrews 4:14,15, 1 John 3:5
- F. The Son of God gives understanding – 1 John 5:20

## 7. OBJECTIONS/ QUESTIONS/ANSWERS

- (1) John 1:1 – Christ is referred to by some as “a god” since there is no definite article in the Greek text before God in this verse.

**Response:** New Testament verses where the definite article is missing before ‘theos’ would then show that God the Father must also be ‘a god.’ The following are New Testament verses that are missing the definite article before ‘theos’ that are thought to refer to God the Father (Matthew 19:26, 27:54, Luke 1:35,78, 2:14,40,52, 3:2, 4:4, 11:20, 12:21, 16:13, 20:38, John 1:6,12,13,18\*, 3:2,21, 8:54, 9:33, 10:33\*, 13:3, 20:17, Acts 5:29,39, etc.).

- (2) John 14:28 – The Father is greater than the Son.

**Response:** The Son is a servant to the Father (John 13:16, 15:20) and is lesser only in the sense of being a servant which is a mystery. As Christ was thought equal to God, He humbled Himself and took the form of a man (Philippians 2:6-8).

- (3) John 20:17 – “the God of Christ”

**Response:** See Hebrews 1:8 and Psalm 2:1-12 where Christ the Son is called God and is to be trusted as the LORD Yahveh is to be trusted (Proverbs 3:5). See also Psalm 45:6,7 where it states that God has a God.

- (4) Psalm 110:1 – adoni (OT#113)) Matthew 22:42-45 is never a reference to God.

**Response:** This is not true. See the following verses which address ‘adoni’ as the LORD God: Exodus 23:17, Deuteronomy 10:17, Joshua 3:11,13, Psalm 8:1, 45:11, 97:5, 135:5, 136:3, 147:5, Isaiah 1:24, 3:1, 10:16, Micah 4:13, Zechariah 4:14)

- (5) Matthew 26:39 – There are two different wills in the Godhead? “And (NT#2532) he went (NT#4281) a little (NT#3397) further (NT#4281), and fell (NT#4098) on (NT#1909) his (NT#846) face (NT#4383), and (NT#2532) prayed (NT#4336), saying (NT#3004), O my (NT#3450) Father (NT#3962), if (NT#1487) it be (NT#2076) possible (NT#1415), let (NT#3928) this (NT#5124) cup (NT#4221) pass (NT#3928) from (NT#575) me (NT#1700): nevertheless (NT#4133) not (NT#3756) as (NT#5613) I (NT#1473) will (NT#2309), but (NT#235) as (NT#5613) thou (NT#4771) wilt.”

**Response:** There is no statement here that there are two different wills. Christ’s will is to do that of the Father (i.e. John 4:34, 5:21, 5:30, and 6:38). If we understand that God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are one but yet distinct persons within the Godhead, we can understand that they may show us that there is communication within the Godhead as in Genesis 1:26 and 11:7.

- (6) 1 Corinthians 15:24-28 – “Then (NT#1534) *cometh* the end (NT#5056), when (NT#3752) he shall have delivered up (NT#3860) the kingdom (NT#932) to God (NT#2316), even (NT#2532) the Father (NT#3962); when (NT#3752) he shall have put down (NT#2673) all (NT#3956) rule (NT#746) and (NT#2532) all (NT#3956) authority (NT#1849) and (NT#2532) power (NT#1411) For (NT#1063) he (NT#846) must (NT#1163) reign (NT#936), till (NT#891) (NT#3757) he hath put (NT#302) (NT#5087) all (NT#3956) enemies (NT#2190) under (NT#5259) his (NT#846) feet (NT#4228) The last (NT#2078) enemy (NT#2190) *that* shall be destroyed (NT#2673) *is* death (NT#2288) For (NT#1063) he hath put (NT#5293) all things (NT#3956) under (NT#5259)

his (NT#846) feet (NT#4228). But (NT#1161) when (NT#3752) he saith (NT#2036) (NT#3754) all things (NT#3956) are put under (NT#5293) *him, it is* manifest (NT#1212) that (NT#3754) he is excepted (NT#1622), which did put (NT#5293) all things (NT#3956) under (NT#5293) him (NT#846) And (NT#1161) when (NT#3752) all things (NT#3956) shall be subdued (NT#5293) unto him (NT#846), then (NT#5119) shall (NT#5293) the Son (NT#5207) also (NT#2532) himself (NT#846) be subject (NT#5293) unto him that put (NT#5293) all things (NT#3956) under (NT#5293) him (NT#846), that (NT#2443) God (NT#2316) may be (NT#5600) all (NT#3956) in (NT#1722) all (NT#3956).

**Response:** As we do not understand everything about the Godhead, we see the following:

- (a) It says “God, even the Father” in verse 24. The word ‘even’ in the King James Bible should be translated as ‘and’ kai NT#2532. As Christ will sit upon the throne of God (Hebrews 1:8, Revelation 3:21, 7:17, 21:5,6 – the Alpha and Omega) and He and the Father are one (John 10:30), we can understand in a limited way that there is a submission within the Godhead.
  - (b) The Son is to honor the Father (Malachi 1:6).
- (7) Mark 13:32 – The Son does not know the day and hour of His return – “But (NT#1161) of (NT#4012) that (NT#1565) day (NT#2250) and (NT#2532) *that* hour (NT#5610) knoweth (NT#1492) no man (NT#3762), no, not (NT#3761) the angels (NT#32) which (NT#3588) are in (NT#1722) heaven (NT#3772), neither (NT#3761) the Son (NT#5207), but (NT#1508) the Father (NT#3962).”

**Response:** The word ‘of’ (Greek word ‘peri’) in this verse may mean ‘concerning’ or ‘pertaining.’ It is possible that this is speaking of the role that the Father and Son have on Judgment Day. See Luke 9:26 and John 5:22. Also, Christ knows all things (John 21:17).

- (8) John 12:49-50 – Jesus did the works of His Father, not His own works. “For (NT#3754) I (NT#1473) have (NT#2980) not (NT#3756) spoken (NT#2980) of (NT#1537) myself (NT#1683); but (NT#235) the Father (NT#3962) which sent (NT#3992) me (NT#3165), he (NT#846) gave (NT#1325) me (NT#3427) a commandment (NT#1785), what (NT#5101) I should say (NT#2036), and (NT#2532) what (NT#5101) I should speak (NT#2980) And (NT#2532) I know (NT#1492) that (NT#3754) his (NT#846) commandment (NT#1785) is (NT#2076) life (NT#2222) everlasting (NT#166): whatsoever (NT#3739) I (NT#1473) speak (NT#2980) therefore (NT#3767), even as (NT#2531) the Father

(NT#3962) said (NT#2046) unto me (NT#3427), so (NT#3779) I speak (NT#2980).” Does this imply that Jesus was not God?

**Response:** This is not saying that Jesus is not God. This is showing us that there is submission within the Godhead as is mentioned elsewhere in this study. See also John 6:38 and 40.

- (9) John 14:9,10 – If Jesus is God, then only Jesus sees the Father... “Jesus (NT#2424) saith (NT#3004) unto him (NT#846), Have I been (NT#1510) so long (NT#5118) time (NT#5550) with (NT#3326) you (NT#5216), and yet (NT#2532) hast thou (NT#1097) not (NT#3756) known (NT#1097) me (NT#3165), Philip (NT#5376)? he that hath seen (NT#3708) me (NT#1691) hath seen (NT#3708) the Father (NT#3962); and (NT#2532) how (NT#4459) sayest (NT#3004) thou (NT#4771) *then*, Shew (NT#1166) us (NT#2254) the Father (NT#3962)? Believest thou (NT#4100) not (NT#3756) that (NT#3754) I (NT#1473) am (NT#2076) in (NT#1722) the Father (NT#3962), and (NT#2532) the Father (NT#3962) in (NT#1722) me (NT#1698)? the words (NT#4487) that (NT#3739) I (NT#1473) speak (NT#2980) unto you (NT#5213) I speak (NT#2980) not (NT#3756) of (NT#575) myself (NT#1683): but (NT#1161) the Father (NT#3962) that dwelleth (NT#3306) in (NT#1722) me (NT#1698), he (NT#846) doeth (NT#4160) the works (NT#2041)”

John 1:18 “No man (NT#3762) hath seen (NT#3708) God (NT#2316) at any time (NT#4455); the only begotten (NT#3439) Son (NT#5207), which (NT#3588) is (NT#5607) in (NT#1519) the bosom (NT#2859) of the Father (NT#3962), he (NT#1565) hath declared (NT#1834) *him*. ”

**Response:** This is part of the mystery that Jesus and the Father are one. In both of these passages it is not mentioned that Jesus sees the Father.

See 1 Timothy 3:16 and the Inspiration of the Bible notes for apparent contradictions for “seeing God.”

- (10) 1 Corinthians 11:3 – “But (NT#1161) I would have (NT#2309) you (NT#5209) know (NT#1492), that (NT#3754) the head (NT#2776) of every (NT#3956) man (NT#435) is (NT#2076) Christ (NT#5547); and (NT#1161) the head (NT#2776) of the woman (NT#1135) *is* the man (NT#435); and (NT#1161) the head (NT#2776) of Christ (NT#5547) *is* God (NT#2316)”. – This implies that Christ is inferior to God.

**Response:** There is a headship in the human race as parents are in charge of their children. In this verse it also states that the “head of the woman is the man.” We also know from Galatians 3:28 that there is no male or female in regards to the standing of any of the true believers (Abraham’s seed) before God. This can be seen as a mystery how men and women believers are still men and women on this earth and yet not be different as

far as the love of God is concerned. In a similar way, so is the mystery of the Godhead. Notice that it does not say that the head of Christ is the Father or God the Father.

- (11) Is Christ a created being that is used by God to be an agent in creation? John 1:3 – All things created were created ‘through’ Christ not ‘by’ Christ – “All things (NT#3956) were made (NT#1096) by (NT#1223) him (NT#846); and (NT#2532) without (NT#5565) him (NT#846) was (NT#1096) not (NT#3761) any thing (NT#1520) made (NT#1096) that (NT#3739) was made (NT#1096).”

**Response:** The word ‘dia’ NT#1223 that is translated in the King James Version in John 1:3 as ‘by’ is translated as “through God” in Romans 11:36 (Him) and 1 Corinthians 1:1, 2 Corinthians 10:4. In these three verses, is God an agent? If so, then God must not be God or the idea of something done through an agent that is not God is not necessarily supported by Scripture. Also, in John 1:3, what are the “all things” that Christ created? If Christ was a created being, when was He created? There was nothing made without Christ according to this verse. Did Christ create Himself? This would be impossible according to John 1:3, Ephesians 3:9 and Colossians 1:16.

- (12) Colossians 1:19 – The claim is made that the “fullness of God” means obedience and not being God Himself. “For it pleased (NT#2106) *the Father* that (NT#3754) in (NT#1722) him (NT#846) should (NT#2730) all (NT#3956) **fullness** (NT#4138) dwell (NT#2730).

**Response:** If the word for fullness means obedience, then it should mean obedience in all places where the Greek word is used (i.e. Mark 2:21, 8:20, Romans 11:12,25, 1 Corinthians 10:26, Ephesians 3:19, Colossians 2:9). Was Christ an inanimate object like a piece of cloth or a basket? Though Christ kept the law perfectly, Colossians 1:19 and 2:9 are speaking of His position in the Godhead. We get another picture of this in John 14:10,11 where it speaks of Christ being in the Father and the Father being in Christ. This is part of the mystery of the Godhead.

- (13) Is Isaiah 9:6 a symbolic prophecy about politics in Damascus and Samaria using a child’s name? Can the phrase “he shall be called” be translated “his name means”?

“For unto us a child (OT#3206) is born (OT#3205), unto us a son (OT#1121) is given (OT#5414): and the government (OT#4951) shall be upon his shoulder (OT#7926): and his name (OT#8034) shall be called (OT#7121) Wonderful (OT#6382), Counsellor (OT#3289), The mighty (OT#1368) God (OT#410), The everlasting (OT#5703) Father (OT#1), The Prince (OT#8269) of Peace (OT#7965)”

**Response:** Where is it mentioned in the Bible about any politics in Damascus or Samaria? This has to do with the will of God above any of man's political agendas. (See Psalm 2:1-4, Colossians 2:8,20). The phrase "he shall be called" is different than the phrase "his name means." When we look up the phrase "shall be called" for example in Genesis 32:28, what was Jacob's name to begin with if it was not Jacob? Should we refer to Jacob as 'blank?' Then we will have many unknown persons in the Bible (see Genesis 16:11, 17:19, 48:6, Isaiah 4:3, Jeremiah 33:16).

- (14) If John 20:28 is saying that Jesus is God, then is Matthew 16:23 saying that Peter is Satan?

John 20:28 "And (NT#2532) Thomas (NT#2381) answered (NT#611) and (NT#2532) said (NT#2036) unto him (NT#846), My (NT#3450) Lord (NT#2962) and (NT#2532) my (NT#3450) God (NT#2316)."

Matthew 16:23 "But (NT#1161) he turned (NT#4762), and said (NT#2036) unto Peter (NT#4074), Get thee (NT#5217) behind (NT#3694) me (NT#3450), Satan (NT#4567): thou (NT#1488) art (NT#3754) an offence (NT#4625) unto me (NT#3450): for thou savourest (NT#5426) not (NT#3756) the things (NT#3588) that be of God (NT#2316), but (NT#235) those that be of men (NT#444)."

Comment – The apostle Thomas calls Jesus 'God' in John 20:28.

**Response:** Of the twelve disciples of Jesus, it was Judas who was identified by Christ as being a devil (John 6:70,71). Peter was not referred to this position. There was an identification to Satan towards Peter that may be associated with Satan desiring to sift Peter as wheat (had an interest in Peter) but the Lord would not allow it (Luke 22:31-32).

Do you think that the Lord would allow Satan to pen two of the epistles of the New Testament? There are names or titles given in the Bible to some that give a picture of something and are not to be taken as literal but as a principle. For example, Jacob wrestled with God in Genesis 32:24-30, prevailed and was called Israel which means to have power with God, yet Jacob was a man who eventually died and had no more physical power during his lifetime than any other man. He was to be part of the lineage of Christ and was loved by God (Malachi 1:2, Romans 9:13). Christ is called the Lamb of God in John 1:36 and is not a literal lamb but served as the perfect pleasing sacrifice to God for the sins of those He died for.

If the apostle Peter was Satan, was there anything Satanic or contradictory in the two epistles of Peter to the rest of the Bible?

When Nathan says to David in 2 Samuel 12:7 "Thou art the man" this is to be taken literally as David is the man who was responsible for the death of Uriah the Hittite. When a title like 'lord' is given in the Old Testament for

a man, it is a title of reverence that was given to certain men in the Old Testament but was different than that given to the Lord God. No other person was called Lord and God as Christ was called. Other verses in Scripture as noted in this study support that Christ was/and is eternal God and Lord.

- (15) In John 17:23, if the Father is in Jesus, can this be understood to be the same for a true believer?

John 17:23 “I (NT#1473) in (NT#1722) them (NT#846), and (NT#2532) thou (NT#4771) in (NT#1722) me (NT#1698), that (NT#2443) they may be (NT#5600) made perfect (NT#5048) in (NT#1519) one (NT#1520); and (NT#2532) that (NT#2443) the world (NT#2889) may know (NT#1097) that (NT#3754) thou (NT#4771) hast sent (NT#649) me (NT#3165), and (NT#2532) hast loved (NT#25) them (NT#846), as (NT#2531) thou hast loved (NT#25) me (NT#1691).”

**Response:** God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit indwell the true believer (Psalm 51:11, Ezekiel 36:27, Matthew 10:20, Romans 8:9,11,13,14, 1 Corinthians 3:16, Galatians 2:20, Ephesians 3:16, Colossians 1:27, 1 John 4:13). However, the true believer is then a true saint (made holy by the blood of Christ – Ephesians 2:13-19, 1 Peter 2:1-10, Revelation 1:5) and is a servant of the true and living God (Luke 17:10, Romans 6:17-22, 12:1-2). The true believer is not God (idolatry) as some would teach but is part of the kingdom of God who worship God in spirit and in truth (John 4:24).

- (16) Is “the Word” in John 1:1 a “channel of reasoning”?

**Response:** The Greek word ‘logos’ is used in this case with describing Christ as being wisdom or logic in Godly terms, not from man’s view. Christ is referred to being “the alpha and omega” (first and last letters of the Greek alphabet – Revelation 1:8,11, 21:6, 22:13) implying that He is Lord over human language and the entire universe. The ‘logos’ is also the message of the gospel (Acts 16:6, 17:11) and the speech of the believer (Colossians 4:6).

- (17) Does “firstborn” mean a created being? – Romans 8:29-30

“For (NT#3754) whom (NT#3739) he did foreknow (NT#4267), he (NT#4309) also (NT#2532) did predestinate (NT#4309) *to be* conformed (NT#4832) to the image (NT#1504) of his (NT#846) Son (NT#5207), that (NT#1519) he (NT#846) might be (NT#1511) the **firstborn** (NT#4416) among (NT#1722) many (NT#4183) brethren (NT#80).”

**Response:** The term firstborn is a title that identifies Christ with being the author of salvation (Zechariah 12:10, Colossians 1:18, Revelation 1:5). Does the “firstborn from the dead” mean that Christ became alive only after he died on the cross? In 1 Corinthians 15:20 Christ is associated with

being firstfruits. Is this saying that Christ is a bunch of physical fruits or is He the salvation of those who have died physically and are in heaven presently?

- (18) Colossians 3:10 – Who is being created and who is doing the creating?

Colossians 3:10 “And (NT#2532) have put on (NT#1746) the new (NT#3501) *man*, which (NT#3588) is renewed (NT#341) in (NT#1519) knowledge (NT#1922) after (NT#2596) the image of him (NT#1504) that created (NT#2936) him (NT#846)”

**Response:** Christ is called the image (likeness) of God in 2 Corinthians 4:4 and Colossians 1:15. It is a title that Christ as part of the Godhead is given as He humbled Himself to take on the form of a man dwelling among men (John 1:14) to be the sacrifice for sins of those He came to seek and save. It is the believer that is now a new creation (2 Corinthians 5:17, Ephesians 2:10, 4:24). Ephesians 2:10 and 4:24 clear this up.

Ephesians 2:10 “For (NT#1063) we are (NT#2070) his (NT#846) workmanship (NT#4161), created (NT#2936) in (NT#1722) Christ (NT#5547) Jesus (NT#2424) unto (NT#1909) good (NT#18) works (NT#2041), which (NT#3739) God (NT#2316) hath before ordained (NT#4282) that (NT#2443) we should walk (NT#4043) in (NT#1722) them (NT#846).”

Ephesians 4:24 “And (NT#2532) that ye put on (NT#1746) the new (NT#2537) man (NT#444), which (NT#3588) after (NT#2596) God (NT#2316) is created (NT#2936) in (NT#1722) righteousness (NT#1343) and (NT#2532) true (NT#225) holiness (NT#3742).”

- (19) John 17:3 – who is the only true God?

“And (NT#1161) this (NT#3778) is (NT#2076) life (NT#2222) eternal (NT#166), that (NT#2443) they might know (NT#1097) thee (NT#4571) the only (NT#3441) true (NT#228) God (NT#2316), and (NT#2532) Jesus (NT#2424) Christ (NT#5547), whom (NT#3739) thou hast sent (NT#649)”

**Response:** It is the God of 2 Samuel 7:28, 2 Chronicles 15:3,4, Jeremiah 10:10, Revelation 6:16, 17, Matthew 22:16, John 3:33, 14:6, 1 John 5:20, Revelation 15:3. It is the God of the whole Bible, the Father, Son and Holy Spirit (1 Timothy 3:16).

- (20) John 17:20-23 – Is this speaking of Christ and the Father as being one (John 10:30) and the believers as being one as the bride of Christ or is the Father, Christ and the believers as all being one?



“Neither (NT#1161) (NT#3756) pray I (NT#2065) for (NT#4012) these (NT#5130) alone (NT#3440), but (NT#235) for (NT#4012) them also (NT#2532) which shall believe (NT#4100) on (NT#1519) me (NT#1691) through (NT#1223) their (NT#846) word (NT#3056) That (NT#2443) they all (NT#3956) may be (NT#5600) one (NT#1520); as (NT#2531) thou (NT#4771), Father (NT#3962), *art* in (NT#1722) me (NT#1698), and I (NT#2504) in (NT#1722) thee (NT#4671), that (NT#2443) they (NT#846) also (NT#2532) may be (NT#5600) one (NT#1520) in (NT#1722) us (NT#2254): that (NT#2443) the world (NT#2889) may believe (NT#4100) that (NT#3754) thou (NT#4771) hast sent (NT#649) me (NT#3165) And (NT#2532) the glory (NT#1391) which (NT#3739) thou gavest (NT#1325) me (NT#3427) I (NT#1473) have given (NT#1325) them (NT#846); that (NT#2443) they may be (NT#5600) one (NT#1520), even as (NT#2531) we (NT#2249) are (NT#2070) one (NT#1520) I (NT#1473) in (NT#1722) them (NT#846), and (NT#2532) thou (NT#4771) in (NT#1722) me (NT#1698), that (NT#2443) they may be (NT#5600) made perfect (NT#5048) in (NT#1519) one (NT#1520); and (NT#2532) that (NT#2443) the world (NT#2889) may know (NT#1097) that (NT#3754) thou (NT#4771) hast sent (NT#649) me (NT#3165), and (NT#2532) hast loved (NT#25) them (NT#846), as (NT#2531) thou hast loved (NT#25) me (NT#1691).”

**Response:** This is speaking of the mystery of Christ and His Church (see 1 Corinthians 10:17 and Ephesians 5:32).

- (21) 1 Timothy 2:5 – Is this verse teaching that Christ is not God? What is the mediator?

“For (NT#1063) *there is* one (NT#1520) God (NT#2316), and (NT#2532) one (NT#1520) mediator (NT#3316) between God (NT#2316) and (NT#2532) men (NT#444), the man (NT#444) Christ (NT#5547) Jesus (NT#2424).”

**Response:** Jesus is referred to being a man as He was God in the flesh (John 1:1-14). The following verses have the same Greek word for mediator (mesites – Strong’s NT#3316): Galatians 3:19,20, Hebrews 8:6, 9:15 and 12:24. None of these verses say that the mediator cannot be God.

In the Old Testament, the Hebrew word ‘pahg’ Strong’s OT#6293 is translated in a few places as ‘intercessor.’ In Genesis 32:1,2 the two angels who are understood in the context of this passage to be God, are said to have met (pahg) Jacob. In Isaiah 53:6, “...the Lord God laid (pahg) on Him (Christ) the iniquity of us all.” Also in Isaiah 59:16, it is said that there was no intercessor (pahg), “...His arm brought salvation” making God an intercessor of some sort.

## QUESTIONS

1. If Jesus Christ is not eternal God, then why was He worshipped and did not tell others not to worship Him?
2. Why does it not mention that Christ had worshipped the Father?
3. Why is Jesus Christ referred to as 'Lord' and "the Lord" in the New Testament? God the Father is referred to as Lord in Matthew 11:25 and Acts 17:24.
4. Who saves sinners from sin and eternal damnation, God the Father or Jesus Christ? Who is the Savior? (see 5H under 'Savior', 'saves' and 'deliverer' of this study)
5. Where does the Bible say that God cannot take on the form of a man? Are there not accounts where God has taken on other forms than a Spirit (i.e. the burning bush in Exodus 3:2-4, the whirlwind in Job 38:1, 40:6 and the rock in 1 Corinthians 10:4)?
6. How can Christ sit on the throne of God (Psalm 46:5 → Hebrews 1:8, i.e., Revelation 3:21, 7:15,17, 22:1,3 (one throne)) if God will not share His glory with another? See also Isaiah 42:8 and 48:11. If Christ is eternal God along with the Father and Holy Spirit, then this explains this.
